- 3. Reported that a total of £7,600 had been raised towards the Mayor's Chosen Charities, Brentwood Opportunities for Special People (BOSP) and the Essex Disabled People's Association. The Mayor thanked everyone who had supported the fundraising during his year of office.

Arising from this item, it was suggested that the rules of the Overview and Scrutiny Committee should be reviewed during the year with a view to amending the rules so that the largest/majority group on the Council did not hold the Chairmanship of the Overview & Scrutiny Committee.

 MEMBERS' ALLOWANCES 2003/2004 AND APPOINTMENT OF INDEPENDENT <u>REMUNERATION PANEL</u>: At the meeting of the Ordinary Council on 6.12.2000, the Council adopted from 1.1.2001 a new scheme for Members' Allowances under Section 18 of the Local Government and Housing Act 1989.

At the meeting of the Policy Board on 18.12.2002, Members considered a report on the budget consultation exercise which had been carried out. The top service which the public wished to see reduced was Mayor and Members' services. The Policy Board decided that an independent review should take place of Members' and Mayor's services. Pending the outcome of the review, the allowances for 2003/2004 would be paid in accordance with the scheme approved in December 2000.

Following the decision of the Policy Board on 18.12.2002, at the Special Council meeting on 26.2.2003, Members considered a report on how the review of Mayor and Members' services should be undertaken and Members decided amongst other matters to appoint an Independent Remuneration Review Panel since under the Local Authorities (Members' Allowances England) Regulations 2001, any decision to amend, revoke or replace a scheme of allowances after 4.5.2001 must involve an Independent Panel set up in accordance with those regulations.

The Council gave further consideration to the appointment of the Independent Remuneration Panel.

In addition the Council considered whether Members' Allowances should be increased in accordance with the annual pay award for local government employees as provided for under the current allowances scheme or left until the new Member Remuneration Panel had reviewed the scheme.

RESOLVED:

- 1. Pending the outcome of the review of Mayor and Members Services to pay the Basic Allowance to all Members of the Council as per the scheme approved on 6.12.2000.
- 2. Pending the outcome of the review of Mayor and Members Services to pay the Special Responsibility Allowances with effect from 15.5.2003 approved as per the scheme approved on 6.12.2000.
- 3. To authorise the BT to vary the Special Responsibility Allowances should any change in chairmanships make it necessary to do so.
- 4. To appoint the following to the Independent Remuneration Panel, Mr M Large and Father Bob White for a period of two years together with Mrs Jenny Duncombe, Mr E Nath and Mr P Pryke for a period of three years.
- 5. To take no action with regard to the 3.5% increase in allowances due to be applied with effect from 1.4.03.

15. <u>PARLIAMENTARY CONSTITUENCY BOUNDARIES IN THE COUNTY OF</u> <u>ESSEX:</u> The Boundary Commission for England was undertaking a review of constituency boundaries as required by the Parliamentary Constituencies Act 1986.

The Commission had published its provisional recommendations, based on electorate figures for the year 2000 and in consideration of the average electoral quota for Essex, Southend-on-Sea and Thurrock. The Council had until 16.6.2003

to make any representations in respect of the provisional recommendations.

With regard to the Brentwood & Ongar Parliamentary Constituency, the Commission proposed to add the Epping Forest ward of North Weald Bassett to the existing constituency boundary and to move the Matchings into the proposed Harlow constituency, thereby increasing the electorate by a further 3,315 electors.

It was felt that the suggestion that objection should be raised to the removal of the Matchings from the Constituency required further detailed consideration which would be considered as part of the consultation with the political group leaders.

RESOLVED that the CE&TC be authorised to respond to the Commission, including raising formal objection if necessary, following consultation with the three political Group Leaders on the Council. *[CE&TC-McLintock, ATC-Stevens]*
