ANNUAL COUNCIL 16TH MAY 2012

All present stood for a minute's silence in memory of Janet Hayward, a former Essex County Councillor who had lived most of her life in Headley Chase, Warley. Cllr Tee paid tribute to Mrs Hayward, recounting some of the many achievements she had made during her lifetime.

She thanked the Deputy Mayor, Cllr Mrs Coe, and her husband Paul for fulfilling her engagements at short notice when she had been ill in March.

The Mayor had undertaken many engagements and shared with Members some of the highlights:

- 1. Accompanied by her granddaughter, Sidonie, the Mayor had very much enjoyed attending a concert by the Brentwood Youth Orchestra at St Thomas's Church arranged by the Rotary Club and had been very impressed at the performance.
- 2. She had started off the Brentwood half marathon and fun run in which almost 4000 people took part and which had been sponsored by LV.
- 3. The Mayor attended another family event the Sport Relief mile which was held at Brentwood County High School and which had been organised by Cllr William Lloyd, raising £50,000 for charities.
- 4. She had attended various fund-raising civic dinners to mark the end of the year of office for many Mayors and Chairmen.
- 5. She had enjoyed visiting the Finchingfield home of the High Sheriff for 2011/12, Lady Ruggles-Brize, to witness the inauguration of the New High Sheriff, Christopher Palmer Tompkinson.
- 6. On Easter Saturday she attended Hutton polo fields to blow the first whistle and watch an annual international Football tournament for the under 14's featuring teams

from Germany, Luxembourg and Holland. She was also invited to throw the first pitch at the beginning of the first Baseball game of the season.

- 7. The Mayor attended the Essex Chairman's awards evening where Cllr Rodney Bass presented cheques to two Brentwood charities PHAB and the Brentwood Youth Orchestra.
- 8. She had entertained a group of 40 German students who had made their way from Golders Green by train to see the town of Brentwood.
- 9. A quiz was held at Brentwood County High School where nearly £1200 was raised for the Mayor's Charities. The Mayor thanked those who organised or supported the event.
- 10. She had felt privileged to make a short speech and raise the England flag outside the Town Hall on St Georges Day.
- 11 She had attended a well-staged and enjoyable performance of High Society at Ingatestone Community Centre.
- 12. She thanked Tricia Sharpe and her team for arranging a 24 hour Bounce a thon at the centre in Keys Hall when £700 was raised for the Mayor's Charities.
- 13. Abi's last engagement as the Mayor's canine companion was meeting the children of St Mary's School in Shenfield.
- 14. The Mayor attended the Essex Company of the Year Awards where children from different schools had competed against each other running a company for 10 months.
- 15. Accompanied by her son, the Mayor had attended An Evening with Steve Davis in aid of the Mayor of Havering's charity, St Francis Hospice.
- 16. The Mayor's final event was the End of Year Ball which was held at De Rougemont Manor, Warley. She thanked the organisers of the event and supporters for raising further funds for her charities.

The Mayor's chosen charities for 2011/12 were St Francis Hospice and Recoil Twisters Trampoline Club. 7.
