Peasants' Revolt Recommended Licensing Conditions (Committee Hearing 08/08/23)

The current Licence for the premises does not ensure noise is managed appropriately. I propose the following conditions which will ensure noise is managed and to prevent public disturbance.

- 1. Music should be played at a level agreed with Brentwood Borough Council's Environmental Health team. Sound levels during events should be controlled appropriately by management to ensure a public nuisance is not caused.
- 2. A Noise Management Plan is to be submitted to and agreed by Environmental Health. This should be sufficient to ensure noise from the premises is reasonably managed. Reason: To prevent public nuisance.
- 3. No drinks should be allowed in outside areas after 10pm. Reason: To prevent customers from causing public nuisance at later hours.
