The Sub-committee considered the evidence and submissions before it and following a discussion **RESOLVED** that, while Members supported the decision to suspend the appellant's license following allegations made, the license should be reinstated. However, if further relevant information came to the attention of the licensing department, the Sub-committee would expect the consideration of this license to come before a differently constituted sub-committee for further consideration.
