

Public Guidance for meetings from 19th July 2021

- We would ask that you take a lateral flow test regularly and before each meeting, if you test positive please inform Democratic Service clerk and do not attend Council/Committee.

If you test positive self-isolate until you can get a PCR test taken and have received the result you will then be told what to do by the NHS.

- Wear a face covering when you come into the Council building and when moving around, try and keep a reasonable distance between you and others.
- We would recommend that you continue to use the hand sanitisers.
- Please stay at home if you are unwell, to reduce the risk of passing on other illnesses.
- Please considering individual risks, such as clinical vulnerabilities and vaccination status of those around you.

To reassure you, officers who are attending these meetings will also be asked to take a lateral flow test, they will be wearing face masks as appropriate and using the sanitiser provided.

Only those officers that need to attend will be at meetings at this present time, this like everything is under constant review.
